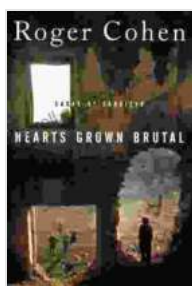


Hearts Grown Brutal: Sagas of Sarajevo

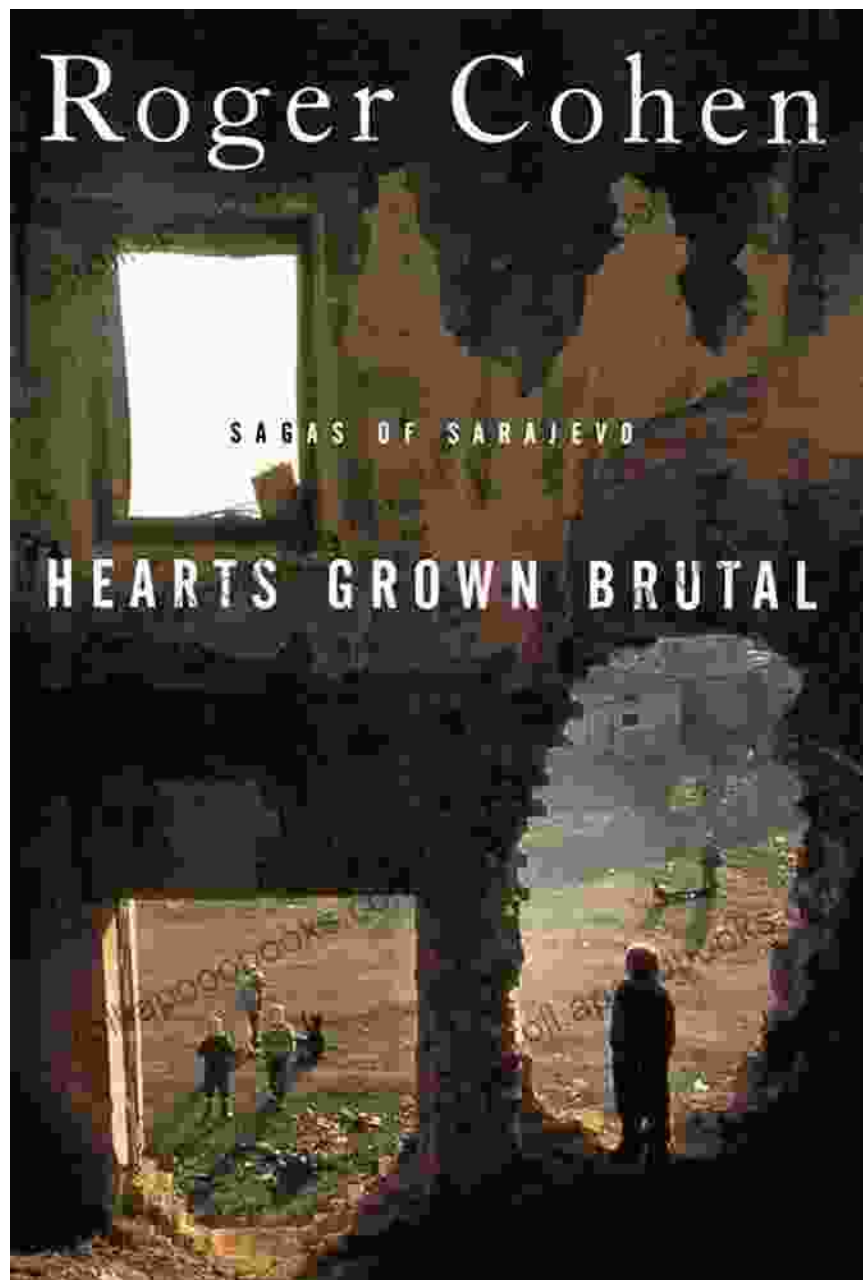

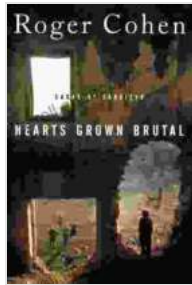

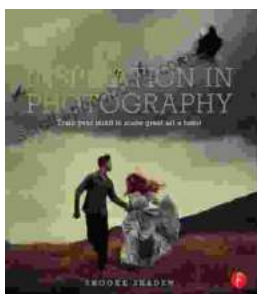
