onto the calyx. - Wrap floral wire around the stem to create a sturdy

support. 5. **Create the leaves:** - Ch 15, sl st into the 2nd ch from the hook.

- Sc 6 times, 2 sc in the next st, sc 6 times. - Repeat on the other side to

create the leaf shape. 6. **Attach the leaves:** - Sew the leaves onto the stem of the rose.

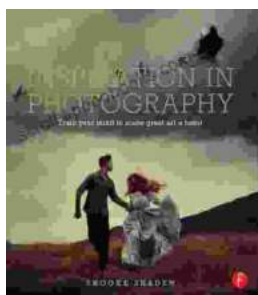
